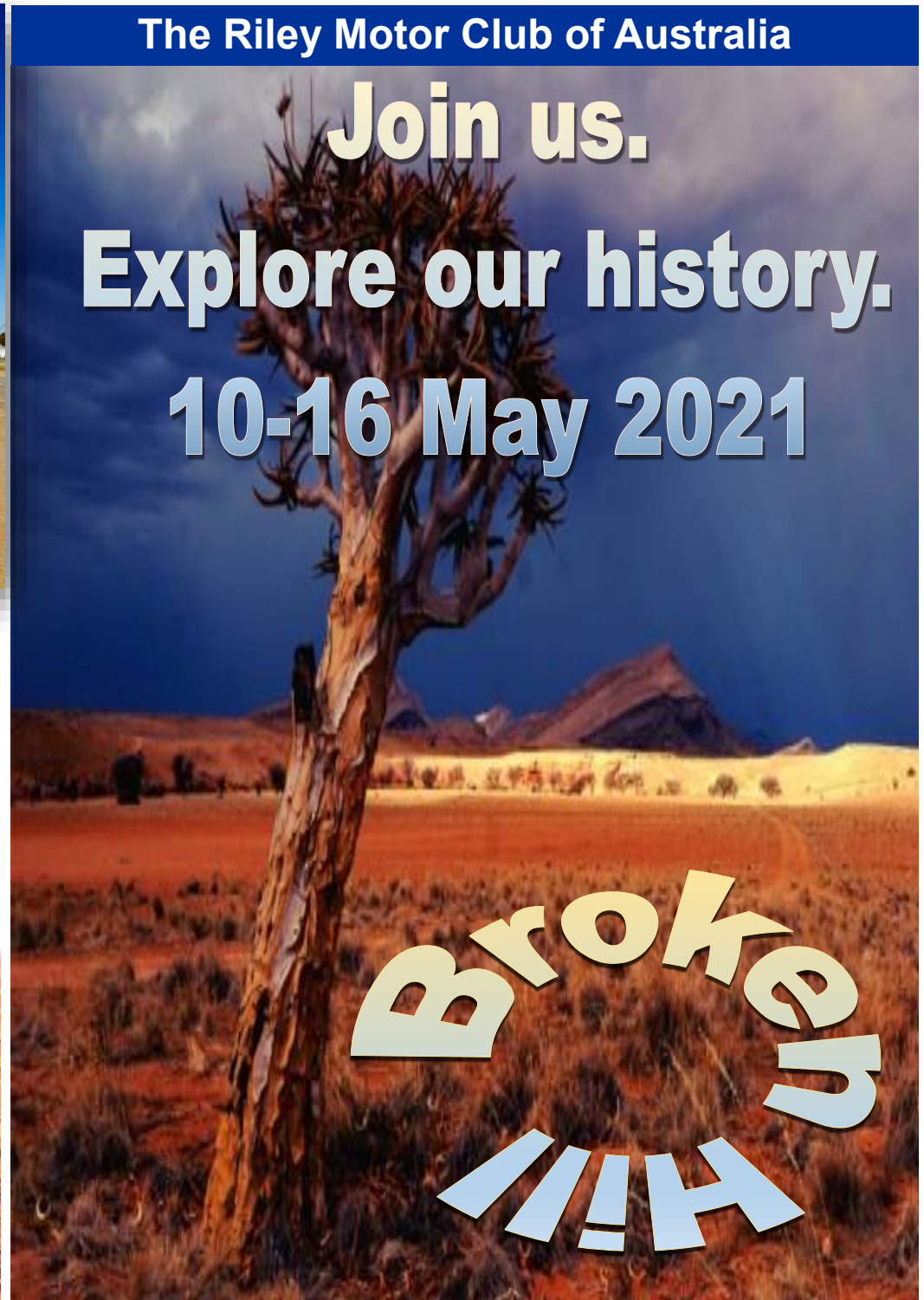
When The Sun's Behind The Hill

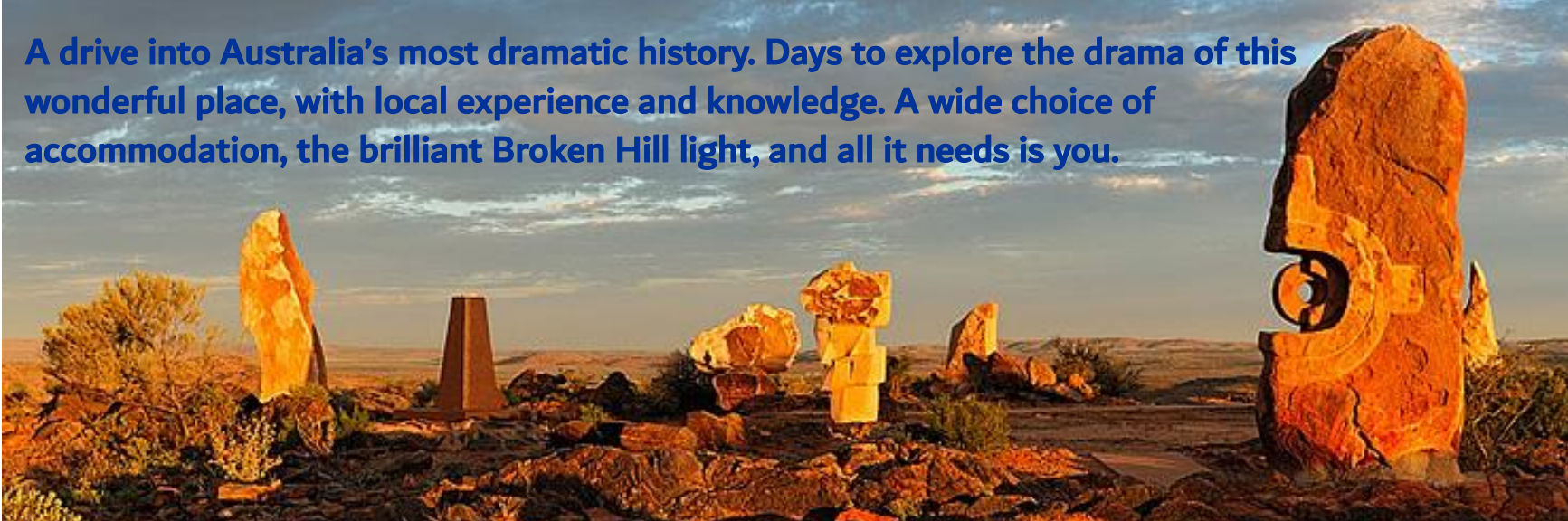
